The Promotion

 - There are 12 challenges in total, for every four completed, visit Discover It at Puke Ariki, discuss your challenges with the librarians who will enter your details to the prize draw.
- 3. The promotion commences 1 July 2019 and ends at 7pm 31 July 2019 (Promotion Period).

The Prize

4. There are ten prizes in total – five \$20 vouchers for Centre City New Plymouth and five \$20 vouchers for Event Cinema New Plymouth.

- 5. To enter, entrants must come in to Discover It at Puke Ariki Library and have completed four of the 12 challenges. Puke Ariki Library staff will take contact details (name, email address, telephone number) and this constitutes as an entry for the prize draw.
- 6. Entry is open to those aged 13-17 years of age who are permanent residents in the New Plymouth District.
- 7. Immediate family members of Council employees are welcome to take part but ineligible to enter the prize draw.
- 8. Entrants can enter the prize draw up to three times in total, upon completion of all 12 challenges.
- 9. Entries received after the Promotion Period will not be eligible for the prize draw.
- 10. Each entrant can only win one prize.
- 11. The prize draw will be held at Discover It, Puke Ariki Library at 7.30pm on 31 July 2019.
- 12. The 10 winners will be contacted by 2 August 2019. If the Council is unable to make contact with a winner after three attempts, they will be entitled to select another winner.
- 13. The parent or legal guardian of an entrant must consent to these terms and conditions prior to participation and claiming any prize.
- 14. The Council may terminate, suspend, modify or cancel the competition (including without limitation varying the prize) at any time by notice published on the Puke Ariki website.
- 15. The Council's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
