

Puke Ariki Design a Library Card Competition Terms and Conditions

1. New Plymouth District Council, through Puke Ariki (**the Council**), is holding a design a library card competition to find three new library card designs. The theme is 'Love Taranaki' and entries will be judged on design, creativity and printability.
2. Entries open on 1 December 2020 and close at 5.00pm on 31 January 2021 (**Promotion Period**).
3. All entries must be submitted on an entry form template which is available from Puke Ariki, any Council Community Library or from the Puke Ariki website page (<http://www.pukeariki.com>).
4. Formats can include drawing, design, illustration, paintings or photographs.
5. Completed entries can be returned to Puke Ariki or any Council Community Library during the Promotion Period or uploaded online onto the Puke Ariki website page. Entries received after the Promotion Period will not be eligible for selection as a library card design.
6. Entry is open to all New Plymouth District residents of all ages.
7. Employees of the Council and their immediate family members are eligible to enter, but are ineligible to win a prize.
8. There is no limit to how many times an entrant can enter the competition.
9. Following submission to the competition, a panel of judges will select a winning design for each of the categories - children, teen and adult cards.
10. Entries must be original artwork. No unauthorised use of any copyright images, photographs, text or other material will be accepted. Artwork should be one-dimensional and horizontal for printing purposes and there should be no glitter, glue or pictures fixed to the artwork.
11. One winner will be selected from each of the three categories (children, teen and adult cards) and each winner will receive a \$100 Prezzy card.
12. Each winning entrant grants to the Council the right to reproduce their design on library cards (edited as necessary to fit the dimensions of the card) and other promotional material now or in the future. No fee or royalties will be payable by the Council. The final library card designs will feature Puke Ariki and Council logos and information.
13. The winning entries will be selected by 12 February and the winners will be contacted by email or telephone. If the Council is unable to make contact with each winner after three attempts, the Council will be entitled to select another winner.
14. The Council's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
15. The Council reserves the right to verify the validity of entries and to re-draw the competition if an ineligible entrant is drawn.
16. The Council reserves the right to use the each winner's name and photograph for promotional media and publicity purposes (including the social media and website pages of Puke Ariki and the Council).
17. Subject to the waiver of privacy as evidenced by the entrant's entry, when collecting personal information, the Council complies with the Privacy Act 2020 and any legislation that replaces that Act.
18. The Council may terminate, suspend, modify or cancel the competition (including without limitation varying the prize) at any time by notice published on the Puke Ariki website.
19. If an entrant is under the age of 18 years they acknowledge that they have their parent/legal guardian's permission to enter the competition and that if they are drawn as a winner that their parent or legal guardian will be awarded the prize, and that the parent or legal guardian of an entrant must consent to these terms and conditions prior to claiming a prize.
