For the safety, wellbeing and security of our staff, visitors, collections and premises, please read the following.



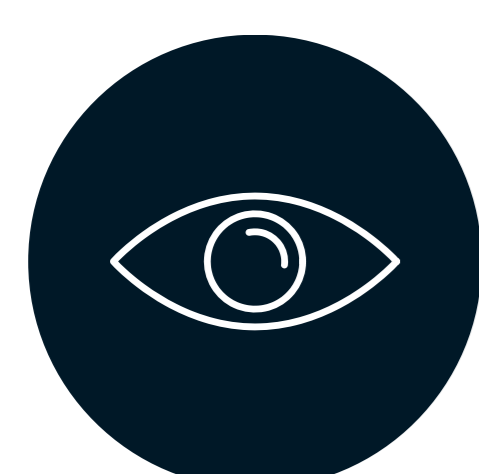
Conduct yourself responsibly and be respectful to others.
